"The Social Connection means a whole lot to me. It is my lifeline. When I'm feeling down, the people at the Connection show a lot of care and concern. We've got a lot of different personalities and characters, but we are all real down to earth good people. Respect and kindness is shown by everyone at the Connection. Good times and fun are a big part of the agenda. I had a great summer last year thanks to the Connection, and I'm looking to repeat this year. I'm a Vietnam Veteran, and this is the most I've ever socialized with people since I came home in 1970. Thank you Social Connection for bringing me back into the world."

"The Connection is an extended family. It is a place I can go to talk about issues. We have a common denominator called mental illness. We share struggles that often trip us up and it is nice to have another person to relate with."
